KEY SCRIPTURE

Judges chapters 2-4, 6- 8, and 13-16

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- In the story of Deborah, what is the relationship between the fortunes of the Israelites and their relationship with the Lord?
- Based on how you saw Gideon use a fleece, how might you use fleeces in your own life when faced with challenging decisions?
- How does the story of Gideon help you in growing your trust in God?
- The story of Samson tells of a man with many flaws. How does this story challenge you or encourage you in your own life?
- How and where are you leading in your own life with God's help?
- In the message we shared the 3 ways to skip Judges, we group them as our 3 C's: 1. Choose to worship God, not pursue my lusts (CELEBRATION) 2. Choose to invest in people, not be self-focused (CONNECTION) 3. Choose to bless others, not be self-consumed (CONTRIBUTION)

Which one of these do you want to improve in and which one are you doing well?

MOVING FORWARD

-Focusing on God at the beginning at end of every day can give us peace and help us truly rest in Him. Each night read and reflect on Judges 6:15. Pray and ask God to help you fully embrace the story of Gideon's growing trust in God. As you do this allow the verse to fully impact your heart and mind.
