DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What area in your life do you need to be strong and courageous? How can this story help you with that?
- What, to you, is the most significant part of the story of Jericho, and why did you choose that part?
- What are some of the ways God joined with Joshua in the battle against the Amorites?
- What battle are you facing right now where you need God to join in with you? How can this group help or support you?
- As Joshua prepared to die, what do you think he was trying to accomplish in his final speech to the people?
- What does it look like for you to have and live out a courageous spirit?
- What next steps do you need to take in your own life based on what we read and discussed together?

-Focusing on God at the beginning at end of every day can give us peace and help us truly rest in Him. Each night read and reflect on Joshua 1:9. Pray and ask God to help you fully embrace the story of Joshua and his courage. As you do this allow the verse to fully impact your heart and mind.
